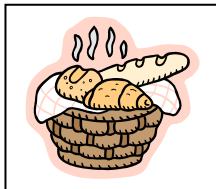
A 3-story sandstone house built in 1857 on the highest hill in Anderson County. Is listed on the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP).

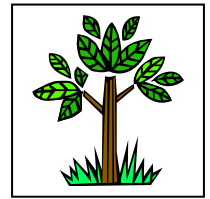
