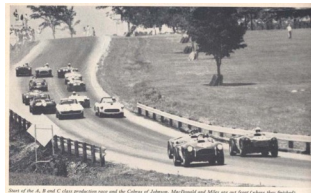

## Garnett-Outdoor Adventures....



Cedar Valley Reservoir - Just out of the city enough to "camp out", yet close enough to town to call for pizza if the sizzle of the barbecue is too well done! CVR is the largest of Garnett's 3 lakes and is great for fishing, boating and camping.

You'll find 3 boat docks and 3 boat ramps, picnic tables, fire rings and rest-rooms. Electric-only RV hook-ups are available, as well as primitive camping throughout the park. ATV trail (permit required) is located at the south end of this park.



North Lake Park - Garnett's most famous park has a vast array of amenities surrounding a beautiful lake. Lake Garnett was the home

of many SCCA road races (1959-1972). KART (go cart) races are held on the 2.8 true road course still today. Water-ski tournaments ([www.intleague.com](http://www.intleague.com)) and NBRA ([www.racenbra.com](http://www.racenbra.com)) boat races are held here. Amenities include the Garnett Country Club Golf Course, football stadium, Anderson County fairgrounds, swimming pool, sand volleyball, baseball/softball, rifle/pistol range, clay shooting range, shelters, playgrounds, a skate park, tennis and more.



### Crystal Lake (South Lake) - Veterans Memorial Park

Looking for some serenity? You've come to the right place. Veterans Memorial Park is a great place to relax, fish or just watch the ducks play. The 51-mile Prairie Spirit Rail Trail passes over the lake's dam.

Rainbow Trout Season is held annually on Crystal Lake, October 15 through April 15.

**Note:** RV campsites with electric and water are available at both Lake Garnett and Crystal Lake at very affordable prices. Campsites are on a first come, first serve basis. Large camping groups may contact the city manager at Garnett City Hall to make reservations at city parks.
